AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TEXT OF THE LEXINGTON TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE TO AMEND REQUIREMENTS GOVERNING ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS RELATING THERETO, AND TO DEFINE TERMS RELATING TO THE SAME

THE TOWNSHIP OF LEXINGTON ORDAINS:

ARTICLE 1:

CHAPTER 23, Administration and Enforcement, Section 23.2.0, is hereby amended as attached.

ARTICLE 2 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE:

The various parts of this ordinance shall be deemed severable. Should any section, paragraph, or provision hereof be held by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part held to be unconstitutional or invalid.

ARTICLE 3 REPEAL:

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict, to the extent that this ordinance conflicts with any other ordinance this ordinance shall control (supersede).

ARTICLE 4 EFFECTIVE DATE:

Public hearing having been held hereon, the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect upon the expiration of seven days after publication, pursuant to the provision of Section 401 (6), Act 110 of the Public Acts of 2006, as amended.

23

Administration and Enforcement

Section 23.1.0 — Authority

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be jointly administered by the Township Planning Commission, Township Board, the Zoning Board of Appeals and the Zoning Administrator in accordance with the Township Rural Zoning Act, Act 184 of 1943, as amended.

Section 23.2.0 — Zoning Administrator

- .01 The Township Board, with recommendation of the Planning Commission, shall employ a Zoning Administrator to administer this Ordinance.
- .02 The Zoning Administrator shall have the power to grant Certificates of Zoning Compliance, certain site plans, and to make inspections of premises necessary to carry out administration and enforcement of this Ordinance.
- The Zoning Administrator shall order discontinuance of illegal uses of land, buildings or structures; removal of illegal buildings or structures; discontinuance of any illegal work being done; and/or shall take any other action authorized by this Ordinance to ensure compliance with or prevent violations of its provisions. Furthermore, the Zoning Administrator, after giving notice to perfect a violation of the ordinance, shall have the right to revoke a land use permit if the violation is not corrected within a reasonable period of time, but in no event shall the violation exceed 90 days unless an extension is granted by the Planning Commission.
