DISCUSSION ON ROADS:

Harrington Rd west off of Lakeshore was not discussed as a road for a rebuild. We were waiting on a price for the redo of Harrington Wildcat – Wixson limestone was not put on this section but we will need to have that part of the road done

Ray stated there will be no ditching this year already booked for 2026. Ray suggested using the money for limestone. Question asked what is the process to hire our own contractor for ditching; 1. Notify County 2. County puts out for bid 3. County decides who will do the project. They use 4 different contractors; 1. Tanton 2. Mc Eachin Excavating 3. Harding and Ray can not remember the 4th one.

Ray received 3-5 phone calls on Babcock Rd South that they would like ditching on the west side $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile south and some on the east

Gielow trucks use Harrington Rd possibly reach out to see if they would help maintain the road. Ray stated there is no restrictions or weight limit they can put on Semis. Limestone timeline – just beginning to haul and will all summer. Ray stated he has gotten quite a few calls residents asking why we are doing the same roads and we should probably pick different roads for limestone. Discussion on how we choose the roads are by the amount of traffic and complaints received. Ray will reach out and see about ditching being done this year and 600 tons is mandatory on limestone.
